Nomination Criteria: The Indiana Journalism Courage Award will be presented to an individual who confronted significant obstacles or pressures in the pursuit of journalism or journalism education. Nominations are open to citizens, journalists, lawyers, public officials, teachers, students and others who are engaged in efforts to hold institutions accountable. For example, prime candidates for the award might include a reporter who faced legal or other impediments to a story, a journalism educator who contended with the threat of censorship, or a citizen who went to extraordinary measures to publish information important to the public.

To Nominate: Please submit this form, along with supporting documentation, including a summary (no more than two pages), letters or affidavits documenting perseverance, and any published or broadcast reports. For print entries, submit three tear sheets of published material; for TV, standard VHS tape, or DVD; for radio, standard audio cassette or CD; and for Web entries, a printed Web transcript with URL.
